Founders Day Awards and Criteria

The Golden Oak Award, Continuing Service Award, Honorary Service Award and the Very Special Person Award are bestowed upon exceptional people to honor them for their outstanding efforts on behalf of children.

Nominate (by Friday, February 8th) the person that you feel to be a true leader and exceptional volunteer in our school and local community—those individuals who have gone beyond

the normal call of volunteerism and display exceptional leadership qualities including: A Definite Goal or Cause, Enthusiasm, Problem Solver, Achiever, Communicator, Courage to Make Tough Decisions, Self-Control, Persistence, a Clear Thinker and Personal Commitment. *The nominee should be recognized for outstanding service to children and youth and not for routine, assigned responsibilities or for retirement.*

Very Special Person Award (VSP): May be given to an individual or a group.

Honorable Service Award (HSA): May be given to an individual in the PTA, school or community in special recognition of outstanding service to children and youth.

Continuing Service Award (CSA): May be given to an individual in the PTA, school or community in special recognition of outstanding service to children and youth. This award may be given to a person whose contributions have been significant over a continuing period of time. The award may be given regardless of whether a recipient has a previously received the California State PTA's Honorable Service Award.

Golden Oak Service Award: May be given to an individual who has made significant contributions to the welfare of children and youth in the school or community. This award should be given to recognize exceptional service to children and youth; it is the California State PTA's most prestigious award.
